



## SWISS FREESKI TOUR – CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- The closing date for registering is as per the announcement.
- The number of competitors is limited. Early registration via the on-line tool is recommended.
- For late entries at the venue, a surcharge of CHF 10.00 applies on top of the official entry fee as per the Basic Info Sheet.
- Entry fee and ticket prices are as per the respective Basic Info Sheets. These can be downloaded via the registration tool.
- System of payment: together with the option of paying by cash at the venue in the Race Office, payment can also be made easily and conveniently on line.
- Entry fees or ticket charges prepaid on line will be refunded only in the case of illness or injury on production of a medical certificate.
- Competitors are responsible for arranging their own insurance cover.
- The wearing of helmets is compulsory.
- The wearing of protective gear (back protection) is recommended.
- Skis and bindings must be in good working order and correctly adjusted.
- By registering, competitors who are still minors declare that their parents or legal guardians are aware of their participation in the Swiss Freeski Tour.
- By registering, every competitor declares automatically that he/she agrees to the applicable competition rules.
- The exact timetable of the contest is published on each competition day.
- By registering, competitors confirm that any visual material (photographs / video or sound recordings) – that are taken or made of them during the Swiss Freeski Open – may be used again, free of charge, in the context of promoting freeskiing.
